# GENERAL RULES (AGE GROUPS)

- Your age group for the Local & Regional Ijtema'at is determined by your age on the 1st of November 2025:
  - For example, if you are 9 years and 9 months old on 1st of November, then you should prepare for the Diyanat (7 to 9 years old) age group for your local & regional ijtema, despite turning 10 before the end of the Atfal year.
  - As an exception, those Atfal turning 7 years old during the year can choose to take part in either Amanat (Under 7s) or Diyanat (7 to 9s) age group with their respective syllabi.
- Your age group for the National Ijtema is determined by what age you will be on the day of the National Ijtema i.e. September 2026.
  - For example, if you are 9 years old on 1st of November 2025, then you should prepare for the Diyanat age group for the your local & regional ijtema. However, if you turn 10 before the National Ijtema, then you should prepare for the Sadaqat (10 to 12 years old) age group for the National Ijtema.

# GENERAL RULES

- All Atfal can take part in all competitions at local and regional Ijtema'at. There are no closed competitions at local and regional Ijtema'at. Closed competitions only apply for the National Atfal Ijtema.
- Only the following competitions at the National Ijtema are closed:
  - Tilawat
  - Nazm
  - Prepared Speech English
- All other competitions are open for Atfal at local, regional and national level.
- Being “closed” means that only the following Atfal will be allowed to take part in these three competitions:
- Those Atfal who have achieved 1st , 2nd or 3rd at Regional Ijtema in any of the three closed competitions.
- Those Atfal who do not get achieve top 3 at their regional Ijtema'at will be able to submit recordings of them reciting portions from the competition they want to be considered for. The National team will try and accommodate for as many as possible.

- Note: If you achieved a position at the Regional Ijtema in a younger age group but have now moved on to an older age group for National Ijtema, you will qualify for the older age group competition.  
E.g. A Tifl was in Dianat group (7-9) for the Regional Ijtema and achieved 1st in Tilawat. If he turns 10 years old before National Ijtema, he will qualify for Sadaqat group (10-12).
- More details on the competitions on offer at the National Ijtema will be shared closer to the Ijtema date. For local and regional Ijtema'at, please contact your local or regional Nazimeen, respectively.

# RULES FOR TILAWAT

- This is a closed competition for the National Ijtema. All Atfal can take part in this at local and regional Ijtema'at. Please consult page 4 of this booklet or see the Ijtema website for more details:

- Participants can recite any of the selected portions from the syllabus.
- A recitation from outside the syllabus will get a total mark of zero.
- Marks will be deducted if the Tifl forgets to recite Ta'awwuz or Tasmiyya.
- There will be no additional marks for reciting from memory.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.
- **Marks will be awarded for:**
  1. Pronunciation - Makharij
  2. Tajweed
  3. Melody - Lehan

- Any one of the Nazms from the syllabus can be delivered.
- At least three couplets are given for each Nazm, any two must be recited without repetition.
- There will be no additional marks for reciting from memory.
- Reading a Nazm from outside the syllabus will get a total mark of zero.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.
  - Marks will be awarded for:
    1. Pronunciation
    2. Quality of Voice
    3. Melody – Lehan

- There will be no additional marks for reciting from memory.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.

  3. Delivery - Way of Expression

# **RULES FOR HIFZ COMPETITION**

- **There are three Hifz Competitions:**
  - Hifz-e-Quran
  - Hifz-e-Ad'iyah
  - Hifz-e-Qasidah
- **These three competitions will be held as separate competitions at National Ijtema.**
- Each participant will be required to answer questions from each of the categories listed above.
- Marks will be awarded according to the different rules for each of the categories listed above. You can see these rules listed below along with the syllabus for each of the categories.
- The judge reserves the right to ask a participant any portion from the Syllabus.
- A participant may take up to 10 seconds before starting their answer.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions will be awarded according to overall score. However, any participant who is able to successfully memorize the syllabus for one category, will receive a prize at National Ijtema.

# RULES FOR HIFZ COMPETITION

- The judge reserves the right to ask a participant any portion from the Syllabus.
- The judge will only give the reference to the portion, for example “Recite Surah Al-Ikhlas” or “Recite Surah Al-Baqarah verse 1 till 7”.
- Giving the first few words of Arabic such as Recite قُلْ هُوَ اللَّهُ may be considered as a hint and may result in mark deduction if the judge decides.
- A participant may take up to 10 seconds before starting their answer.
- **Marks will be awarded for:**
  1. Pronunciation
  2. Accuracy
  3. Fluency

# RULES FOR HIFZ-E-AD'IYAH

- The judge reserves the right to ask a participant any prayer and its translation from the Syllabus.
- The judge will only ask the prayer by giving the title. Asking for the starting words may result in mark deduction. For example, a Tifl may be asked to “Recite the prayer for waking up”
- A participant may take up to 10 seconds before answering.
- **Marks will be awarded for:**
  1. Pronunciation and accuracy of the Arabic
  2. Accuracy of the translation
